The City of Light has no shortage of over-the-top luxury hotels

## HÔTEL DE CRILLON [crillon.com](http://crillon.com)

Since 1909, when it was transformed from a private residence into a regal palace hotel, the Hôtel de Crillon has become the destination of choice for celebrities, royalty and heads of state when visiting Paris. A recent \$25 million renovation restored its Louis XV-style guest rooms, incorporating rich silks, brocades and velvets.

## THE FOUR SEASONS GEORGE V PARIS [fourseasons.com/paris](http://fourseasons.com/paris)

The recently renovated George V's Art Deco details, 17th-century Flanders and Aubusson tapestries, marble floors, inlaid wood furniture, crystal chandeliers and 19th-century sculptures have attracted some of the world's most well-known luminaries, including Marlene Dietrich, Greta Garbo, Sophia Loren and John Wayne.

## HÔTEL PLAZA ATHÉNÉE [plaza-athenee-paris.com](http://plaza-athenee-paris.com)

If you're a *Sex and the City* fan, you might recall from the final episodes a fancy hotel with gorgeous signature scarlet awnings and panoramic views of the Eiffel Tower, Montmartre, the Seine and classic French rooftops.

## HÔTEL RITZ PARIS [ritzparis.com](http://ritzparis.com)

Located in the beautiful and historic Place Vendôme, the Ritz is one of the world's most famous hotels. Each guest room features fine rugs, marble fireplaces, tapestries, big brass beds and famous massive marble baths. The tucked-away Hemingway Bar offers books and booze, and it remains loyal to the original cozy wood-paneled décor that the prolific American writer enjoyed.

## HÔTEL LE BRISTOL [hotel-bristol.com](http://hotel-bristol.com)

The little touches and elegant-but-quirky character distinguish Hôtel Le Bristol from other swanky Parisian palaces. The mid-18th century building has attracted numerous Americans in Paris, including Ava Gardner, Marilyn Monroe and Charlie Chaplin.
